 - iv. What is the commercialization potential of your solution
 - v. Include shots of market survey and customer interviews
 - vi. Impact of the proposed solution must be brought out clearly i.e. if the proposed solution has any social or societal relevance etc.
 - vii. Any other detail / point that the team might want the judges to know must also be covered in the video
 - viii. This video will be used a precursor to evaluation of the form and candidates should not

use this medium for any inappropriate communication.
